FAQ’s

If I am in the PTO Connect system am I a member of the PTSO? No, the PTO Connect system is a communication database for the PTSO.

If I am registered in the CISD Portal (Infosnap) am I also in the PTO Connect system? No, they are two separate systems and do not share information.

If I join PTSO do I need to attend the monthly meetings? No, the only people required to attend the meetings are the PTSO Board members. But any parent or learner is welcome at our PTSO meetings.

If I join PTSO will my learner’s information be included in the learner directory? Only if you give permission. There is a place to give permission on the Membership Form. Also there will be a link in an upcoming “Hot Sync” to give permission.

If I join PTSO do I have to volunteer? No. PTSO is always glad to have parents volunteer but it is not required. For those who would like to volunteer there will be links to opportunities in the “Hot Sync” for volunteers.

Keep up-to-date with all the “happenings” at New Tech High @ Coppell. Stay informed and receive timely and important information on school activities and events. This is a separate communication link than what you will receive from NTH@C administration.
